A proxy will also be entitled to vote at his discretion on any resolution properly put to the Meeting other than those set out in the notice convening the Meeting.
- 5. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be signed either under its common seal or under the hand of any officer or attorney or other person duly authorised.

In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holder(s), and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company.

To be valid, you are requested to lodge this form, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed (or a notarially certified copy thereof) with the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours (excluding any part of a day that is a pubic holiday in Hong Kong) before the time appointed for holding the Meeting (or any adjournment thereof).
